

## VENTURE CENTER LIBRARY – RULES FOR INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERSHIP (Revised: 1 Jan 2010)

(VENTURE CENTER LIBRARY – RULES FOR INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERSHIP (Dated: March 2011))

### Terms

- All general rules of the VC Library shall apply. (as discussed in document “ VENTURE CENTER LIBRARY- RULES AND REGULATIONS”)
- Who is eligible?
  - Category 1: For profit registered companies
  - Category 2: Not-for-profit registered entities (Section 25 Companies, Societies, Trusts)
- Benefits provided:
  - The Library provides each institution with 5 cards. Each card shall allow a member to issue 2 books at any given time.
  - At any given time, only 5 members are allowed to use the library. Each member visiting the Library has to bring a card with them.
  - The cards are issued in the name of the institution and are transferable between members of the institution.
  - The institution has to identify one person who shall be the single point contact for all library related matters.
  - The liability for any penalties and fines lies with the institution.
- The Library reserves its right to changes/discontinue certain services (and related rules/ pricing) from time to time.
- The Librarian holds the right to evict any person or member from the library premises without giving any specific reason.

### Membership fee

### Deposits for issuing rights

Standard deposit for issuing 2 books per card (for all 5 cards)	Rs 10000

### Longer duration discounts

2 year fee – upfront payment	10%
3 year fee – upfront payment	20%

### Category discounts

Not-for-profit entities	50%	50%	None
